5

6 PREAMBLE  
7

8 We the members of the Constitution Party gratefully acknowledge the blessing of the Lord God as  
9 Creator, Preserver and Ruler of the Universe and of this Federal Republic. We hereby appeal to  
10 Him for aid, comfort, guidance and the protection of His Divine Providence.  
11

12 ARTICLE I - NAME  
13

14 The name of this political party shall be the Constitution Party, and hereinafter may be referred to  
15 as the national party but an affiliated state party may elect a different name for use within its state  
16 pursuant to the laws of the state and the constitution and bylaws of the state party.  
17

18 ARTICLE II - PURPOSE  
19

20 The purpose of the Constitution Party shall be to:  
21

- 22 A. Provide a national vehicle through which the member state affiliates may fully participate in the  
23 national election process, including the nomination of national candidates and the adoption of  
24 national platforms;  
25 B. Provide services to state affiliates, at their request, including assistance in ballot qualification,  
26 voter education, organization, and communication; and  
27 C. Promote by all lawful and truthful means the election of Presidential and Vice Presidential  
28 candidates nominated by the Constitution Party and to conduct and coordinate campaigns in  
29 their behalf;  
30 D. Promote allegiance to the principles and objectives of the Declaration of Independence and the  
31 Constitution of the United States of America and the Bill of Rights as conceived and set forth  
32 by our Founding Fathers in their establishment of our Republic; that the Declaration of  
33 Independence occupies a primary and defining relationship to and equality with the  
34 Constitution of the United States of America, and that the latter document was never intended  
35 to supplant nor replace the former document, but only to perfect it and the Union of States  
36 which it brought into existence.

38 ARTICLE III - STATE AFFILIATION  
39

40 State affiliation with the Constitution Party shall be limited to one political party or organization  
41 from each state and the District of Columbia, each of which such entities herein be referred to  
42 as a "state affiliate."  
43

44 The National Committee shall have the power to grant and revoke state affiliation status.  
45

46 Nothing in this Constitution or the bylaws of the Constitution Party shall confer upon the national  
47 party any authority to direct the internal affairs of any state affiliate.  
48

49 ARTICLE IV - NATIONAL CONVENTION  
50

51 For each year in which a President of the United States is to be elected, the Constitution Party shall  
52 hold a national nominating convention for the purposes of:  
53

- 54 A. Nominating candidates for President and Vice President who will agree to adhere to the

- 1 platform adopted by the Constitution Party;  
2 B. Adopting a national platform for the party; and  
3 C. Transaction of any other appropriate business.  
4

5 Rules pertaining to the call and organization of the National Convention shall be adopted by the  
6 National Committee or its executive committee.  
7

8 The National Convention is recognized as the highest authority in the national party. A platform  
9 adopted by a National Convention may be amended only by a National Convention.  
10

#### 11 ARTICLE V - NATIONAL COMMITTEE

12 Between National Conventions, the business of the Constitution Party shall be conducted by a  
13 National Committee consisting of the qualified representatives of the state affiliates.  
14 Qualifications and duties of the officers, procedures concerning the times and places of meetings,  
15 and rules and procedures for governance of the National Committee and the Executive Committee  
16 shall be set forth in the bylaws of the Constitution Party.

#### 19 ARTICLE VI – AMENDMENTS

20 This Constitution may be amended by the majority vote of the delegates present at any National  
21 Convention, or with previous notice by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members present at any  
22 National Committee meeting.
